Good Morning, Parents!

The RTR School District is investigating the possibility of bringing our middle school and high school students back into our buildings more often than two (2) times each week. In our discussions and measuring of 6 ft. social distancing spaces, we feel that we can safely bring 67% or 2/3 of our MS/HS students back into our buildings as many as (3 to 4) times each week. This would be a 67% increase to our current Hybrid Learning Plan.

This survey is an attempt to see what parents think the MS/HS educational model should be for the second quarter and beyond? Is the proposed Hybrid model change one that parents would support starting on November 3, 2020? Or do parents feel the district should stay with our current hybrid plan and not make changes at this time? The current (PreK-5) In-Person Plan would stay the same.
