

## Good Afternoon, RTR Parents!

The RTR ISD #2902 had been notified that someone within the district has tested positive for COVID-19. We are working with the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) and County Public Health for guidance as well as following the COVID-19 Decision Tree provided by MDH. If you or your child is considered a close contact, you will be contacted individually by the school and/or MDH. If you are not contacted during this contact tracing period, your child is not considered a close contact and therefore are not at any greater risk of COVID-19.

For your information, there will be another community-wide COVID-19 testing event on October 27, 2020, from 12:00-6:00 p.m., located at the Rock Christian Youth Center in Tyler, MN. Testing is free and open to all, with or without symptoms. To avoid long lines, community members are encouraged to pre-register for a time slot.
